## RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- **Do you owe any rent from sometime between March 2020 and now?**
- **Have you had financial hardship due to COVID-19**
- **Have you been unemployed for 90 days or more?**

If your answer is yes to any of these questions, you may qualify for rental assistance.

## LEGAL & OTHER AID

- **Local Pro Bono Lawyers**

Washington's eviction moratorium has been replaced with some continued tenant protections. Now is the time to act. Apply for rent assistance for all unpaid rent (contact OlyCAP). Rent assistance is available regardless of citizenship or immigration status. For unpaid rent, craft a repayment plan with your landlord (contact Peninsula Dispute Resolution Center to mediate, and get the plan in writing). If you are facing eviction, you may qualify for free legal assistance. Contact Northwest Justice Project or Clallam-Jefferson Pro Bono Lawyers.
